**Action on IATA Agreement
Issued by the Department of Transportation
on the 28th day of January, 1991**

Docket: 47332, R-1 through R-4 1/

Description: The agreement rescinds Resolution 834, dealing with the placement of electronic equipment in agent offices, in the wake of the Department's disapproval in Orders 90-7-36 and 90-7-57; revalidates Resolution 854, which replaced Resolution 834 and which was approved by Order 90-9-19, for an indefinite period; adds additional countries to the list of countries where provisions of Resolution 800x apply; and adopts new Resolution 887b extending reduced fare transportation to delegates attending official meetings of the of the European Cargo Agency Program Joint Council.

We do not find that the resolutions incorporated in the above docket are adverse to the public interest or in violation of the Act, provided that approval is subject, where applicable, to conditions previously imposed.

Accordingly, we approve and grant antitrust immunity to the agreement, subject, where applicable, to conditions previously imposed.

This order shall be effective and become the action of the Department of Transportation upon the expiration of ten days, unless within such period a petition for review is filed pursuant to 14 CFR 385.50 or the Department gives notice that it will review this order on its own motion. Such actions are subject to judicial review under 49 USC 1486.

Given the noncontroversial nature of this agreement and the availability of the above procedure, we are waiving the 21-day period prescribed by 14 CFR 303.42.
