ORDER FIXING FINAL SERVICE MAIL RATES

SUMMARY

By this order the Department is fixing final international service mail rates for the period July 1 through December 31, 1991. The final rates shall apply as temporary rates beginning January 1, 1992, until further order of the Department.

BACKGROUND

By Order to Show Cause 91-12-24, served December 20, 1991, the Department proposed final international service mail rates to be effective from July 1 through December 31, 1991. The proposed rates reflected increases of 11.2, 5.0, 14.8 and 0.7 percent in the Atlantic, Pacific, Latin American and Transborder entities, respectively, from the final rates in effect for the second quarter of 1991.

The time designated for filing a notice of objection has expired and none has been filed. Therefore, since no one has objected to the findings and conclusions set forth in Order 91-12-24, the Department affirms and adopts them. We enter this final order fixing the rates specified in Order 91-12-24 in accordance with the Department's Regulations 14 CFR 302.306.

Accordingly, under authority assigned by the Department of Transportation in its organization regulations, 14 CFR 385.14:

1. We make final the tentative findings and conclusions specified in Order 91-12-24;
2. The fair and reasonable final rates of compensation to be paid in their entirety by the Postmaster General pursuant to the provisions of section 406 of the Federal Aviation Act of 1958, as amended, for the transportation of mail by aircraft, the facilities used and useful therefor, and the services connected therewith, by each holder of a certificate authorizing the transportation of mail by aircraft in the Atlantic, Pacific, Latin American and Transborder rate areas ^{1/} for the period from July 1 through December 31, 1991, are those specified in the attached Appendices A-1 and A-2;
3. Ordering paragraph 3(g) of Order 79-7-16, incorporated by reference, is amended by adding the following:

	<u>Standard Container</u>	<u>Daylight Container</u>
July 1 through December 31, 1991	4.899 cents	4.858 cents

4. The fair and reasonable temporary rates of compensation for the transportation of mail by aircraft in international services for the period January 1, 1992, until further order of the Department shall be the final rates established for the period July 1 through December 31, 1991;
5. The terms and conditions applicable to the transportation of each class of mail at the rates established here are those set forth in Civil Aeronautics Board Orders 79-7-17 and 79-7-16; and
6. We shall serve this order upon all parties to this proceeding.
