Action on IATA Agreement
Issued by the Department of Transportation
on the 16th day of January, 1992

Dockets: 47856, R-1 and R-2; and
47854, R-1 through R-9 1/

Description: The agreement in Docket 47856 deals with North/Mid/South Atlantic passenger fares, revalidating selected resolutions through February 29, 1992; rescinding selected resolutions, pending adoption of replacement resolutions for TC123 fares (Mid/South and North Atlantic), effective March 1, 1992; and amending fare construction and combination provisions between Canada and India/Pakistan. The agreement in Docket 47854 establishes normal, excursion, and other special fares between Sendai, Japan, and Pusan and Cheju, Korea.

We do not find that the resolutions incorporated in the above dockets are adverse to the public interest or in violation of the Federal Aviation Act, as amended, provided that approval is subject, where applicable, to conditions previously imposed.

Accordingly, we approve and grant antitrust immunity to the agreements, subject, where applicable, to conditions previously imposed.

This order shall be effective and become the action of the Department of Transportation upon the expiration of ten days, unless within such period a petition for review is filed pursuant to 14 CFR 385.50, or the Department gives notice that it will review this order on its own motion. Such actions are subject to judicial review under 49 USC 1486.

Given the noncontroversial nature of these agreements and the availability of the above procedure, we are waiving the 21-day period prescribed in 14 CFR 303.42.
