ORDER DISMISSING PETITION

On October 16, 1992, the Department of Transportation's Office of Automated Tariffs, acting under authority delegated under 14 CFR 385.13, denied a Special Tariff Permission Application (STPA) of Alitalia Linee Aeree Italiane, S.p.A. (Alitalia). The STPA sought the Department's permission to file tariff revisions on less than statutory notice to extend the selling period for its "Visit Italy" and "Europlus Air Pass" fares through December 1993.

On October 26, 1992, Alitalia filed a petition for review of staff action. 1/ Questions regarding treatment of these various fare plan proposals were successfully resolved through governmental consultations between the United States and Italy held on May 14, 1993. Accordingly, we will dismiss Alitalia's petition as moot.

ACCORDINGLY,

1. We dismiss the petition of Alitalia Linee Aeree Italiane, S.p.A. in Docket 48458 as moot;
2. We grant the motions of Alitalia Linee Aeree Italiane, S.p.A. and of Trans World Airlines, Inc. to file otherwise unauthorized documents in Docket 48458; and
3. We will serve a copy of this order on Alitalia Linee Aeree Italiane, S.p.A.; Trans World Airlines, Inc. and the Ambassador of Italy in Washington, D.C.
