- A. At its option, Transbrasil may use some, all or none of the seats from the soft block for DL revenue passengers.
- B. At its option, Transbrasil may return one or more of the seats from the soft seat block at any time up to 7 days before departure date of the flight.
- C. At any time up to 7 days before the departure date of the flight, either party may request additional seats from the other, although neither party shall have the obligation to release seats to the other.
- D. The number of seats debited to Transbrasil for each one way flight listed in Paragraph 1 above shall equal the number of seats from the soft block not returned by Transbrasil up to 7 days before the departure date of the flight.
