Dear Ms. Bingham:

Pursuant to the blanket Statement of Authorization granted to United Air Lines, Inc. ("United") and Lufthansa German Airlines ("Lufthansa") on April 9, 1998 (Order 98-4-8), United and Lufthansa hereby notify the Department that United will place its "UA" designator code on flights operated by Lufthansa:


- between Brussels, Belgium (BRU) and Berlin (TXL), Hamburg (HAM), and Munich (MUC)
- between Frankfurt, Germany (FRA) and Detroit (DTW) and Philadelphia (PHL)

The proposed code-share services are consistent with both the U.S.-Belgium and U.S.-Germany Open Skies Air Transport Agreements. The services will be implemented on January 16, 1999 and April 5, 1999, respectively.
