Dear Ms. Bingham:

Pursuant to the blanket Statement of Authorization granted to United Air Lines, Inc. ("United") and Lufthansa German Airlines ("Lufthansa") on April 9, 1998 (Order 98-4-8), United and Lufthansa hereby notify the Department that Lufthansa's "LH" designator code will be placed on flights operated by United:

- between Chicago (ORD) and Atlanta (ATL), Dallas (DFW), Miami (MIA), Orlando (MCO), San Francisco (SFO), and Tampa (TPA)
- between Washington (IAD) and Atlanta (ATL), Boston (BOS), Detroit (DTW), Las Vegas (LAS), Los Angeles (LAX), Miami (MIA), San Diego (SAN), and San Francisco (SFO)


The proposed code-share services are consistent with the U.S.-Germany Open Skies Air Transport Agreement. The services will be implemented on March 20, 1999.
