

("Air France") Regarding Codeshare Service to Colmar, France**

Dear Mr. Gretch:

Pursuant to the blanket statement of authorization granted to Delta and Air France on August 6, 1998 (#98-303), Delta and Air France hereby notify the Department that from July 17, 2000, to August 25, 2000, the carriers plan to operate codeshare services to Colmar, France, by displaying Delta's "DL" designator code on flights operated by Air France between Paris (CDG) and Colmar. This codeshare service will be operated in lieu of Paris-Strasbourg service normally operated by Air France because runway construction is scheduled to take place at Strasbourg's airport between July 17 and August 28, 2000.
