Continental and Aeroflot

Shared Code Segments

Shared Code Segments will be operated on the following routes:

1. Gateway Segments. Gateway Segments shall be any scheduled service operated by Continental between (i) EWR and SVO; and
2. Free Sale Segments. Free Sale Segments shall be mutually agreed to scheduled service operated by (a) Aeroflot between MIA and SVO and (b) Continental, or its wholly owned subsidiaries, between (i) EWR and another location served by Continental and (ii) locations in the US served by both Aeroflot (via transatlantic service) and Continental and other locations served by Continental. Neither carrier shall have an obligation to place its designator code on flights operated by the other carrier unless or until such time as the carrier whose designator code will be used elects, at its discretion, to do so.

The following chart indicates where, subject to government approval, Aeroflot currently desires to schedule free-sale segments effective on or after the effective date of this Agreement.
