

EXHIBIT 1

GENERAL INFORMATION

- a. Japan Airlines Company, Ltd. (JAL), is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Japan. Its head office is located at 2-4-11 Higashi-Shinagawa, Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo 140, Japan.
- b. The government air transport authority having regulatory jurisdiction over JAL is the Japan Civil Aeronautics Board (JCAB), which is under the authority of the Ministry of Transport (MOT). MOT is located at 1-3, Kasumigaseki 2-chome, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo. As a privately owned Japanese airline, JAL is subject to the Japanese aeronautical authorities, but otherwise has no relationship with the government of Japan. JAL does not receive or expect to receive financial assistance from the government of Japan.
- c. JAL is a publicly-held corporation with approximately 170,000 shareholders, none of whom hold more than 5% of the capital stock of JAL. Ownership and control of JAL has remained substantially unchanged.
- d. Applicant has not been involved in any safety or tariff violations or fatal accidents within the last five (5) years.
- e. Japan is a contracting state to the Convention on International Civil Aviation. JAL's maintenance program complies with the provisions of ICAO Pilots and Airmen Annex 1, 6 (Part 1), and 7.
- f. JAL is unable at this time to provide the information requested in Section 211.20(c) and Section 211.20(p) of the Department's Regulations, as it will execute the authority sought in this proceeding incrementally. With respect to the immediate future, JAL plans to increase weekly combination frequencies as soon as possible in the Tokyo-Chicago and Los Angeles-Sao Paulo markets.
- g. The government of Japan grants fifth freedom rights to incumbent U.S. carriers consistent with the terms of the 1998 MOC.
