TO TERMINATE SCHEDULED AIR SERVICE
AT SCOTTSBLUFF, NEBRASKA

Pursuant to Title 49 of the U.S. Code, Section 41719, air service termination notice, Great Lakes Aviation, Ltd. hereby serves its notice of intent to terminate the scheduled air service it is providing at Scottsbluff, Nebraska.

2. At the time of the filing of this notice, Great Lakes Aviation, Ltd., operating as Great Lakes Airlines provides service at Scottsbluff, Nebraska. Great Lakes' schedules are operated utilizing its own ZK two letter code and reservation system. The company also provides high quality connections, sold through its United Airlines and Frontier Airlines code-share agreements.
3. Great Lakes Airlines service at Scottsbluff currently consists of three weekday non-stop round-trips to Denver International Airport, a major connecting hub for United Airlines and Frontier Airlines, in 19-seat Raytheon/Beech 1900D equipment.
4. Great Lakes Airlines provides the only scheduled passenger air service at Scottsbluff, Nebraska.
5. The Great Lakes Airlines service being offered is as follows:



All flights operate one-stop in 19 seat Beech 1900D equipment.
All times are local time in effect as of the date of this notice.

6. Increasing costs and a reduction in passenger revenue in the post September 11th environment has caused Great Lakes to incur losses in providing scheduled service at many service points. Given the current economic downturn and a potential war with Iraq, it is unlikely that any significant improvement will occur in the near future.
7. As published in the Company's 10-K and annual reports for the year 2001, Great Lakes Aviation reported a net loss of \$18,634,000.

8. Should the DOT choose not to "hold in" Great Lakes, the company would coordinate with other airlines the reaccommodation of passengers ticketed for travel beyond May 17, 2003 at no penalty to passengers, or offer a full refund at no penalty if requested.
9. The effective date of this notice is February 17, 2003.
10. The effective date of this intended termination is May 17, 2003 (the last day of scheduled service would be May 17, 2003).
11. Objections, if any, to this Notice are due on March 7, 2003.


