I hereby request a waiver from the Department's Public Charter regulations to permit C&T Charters, Inc. to cancel on less than 10 days notice all of the remaining flights with Lloyd Aereo Boliviano S.A. for March 29 through May, 2007. These flights were approved in PC No. 06-146. Enclosed is a check in the amount of \$ 39.00 for filing fees.

C&T Charter has contracted for the services of other direct air carriers to accommodate all passengers on the canceled flights. Miami Air International will operate the flight to Havana on March 29, 2007. The balance of the schedule will be operated by Sky King.

Grant of the requested waiver is in the public interest as it will permit C&T Charters to replace a carrier that appears to be incapable of performing the services for which C&T Charters had contracted and provide transportation to all passengers who have been ticketed.
