On behalf of Aviation Advantage Inc. d/b/a Southern Skyways (AAI), this is to inform the Department of cancellation of the July 15 Rockford, IL-Bowling Green, OH round trip. AAI advises that all passengers booked on the canceled flight have been notified and provided a full refund.

In regard to the above, to the extent necessary, Aviation Advantage requests a waiver to late-file this notice. The decision to cancel this flight was made on Saturday, July 5th. Aviation Advantage apologizes for not notifying the Department earlier, but today is the first business day since the decision to cancel was made. Nevertheless, all affected passengers (of which there were only approximately 30) received prompt notices of cancellation and refunds, thus consumers were protected as intended by the Department's regulations.

The waiver requested here is granted under assigned authority. *We find that there are special and unusual circumstances and that the waiver is in the public interest.
