**ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION**

On September 12, 1995, Maverick Airways Corporation (Maverick) filed an application in Docket OST-95-645 for a certificate to provide interstate scheduled air transportation of persons, property, and mail pursuant to section 41102 of Title 49 of the United States Code (Transportation).

On October 18, 1995, we requested that the applicant supply additional information related primarily to Maverick's financing plan. On December 20, 1995, Maverick requested, and we granted, an extension until January 5, 1996, to allow the applicant a reasonable amount of time to obtain the required funding.

On January 5, 1996, Maverick submitted a motion to withdraw its application for refiling at a later date when it will be able to meet the requirements under Part 204 of the Department's regulations.

**ACCORDINGLY,**

1. We dismiss, without prejudice, the application filed by Maverick Airways Corporation in Docket OST-95-645 requesting a section 41102 certificate authorizing interstate scheduled air transportation of persons, property, and mail.
