**AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION OF DELTA AIR LINES, INC.
FOR RENEWAL OF FREQUENCY ALLOCATION**

Delta Air Lines, Inc. ("Delta") hereby amends its application for renewal of its allocation of frequencies to provide U.S.-Ukraine service, filed on June 30, 1998. Delta is submitting this amendment to provide the Department with updated information on Delta's U.S.-Ukraine service plans. Delta has discontinued its service to Kiev and Odessa, Ukraine, via Vienna, Austria, in conjunction with Austrian Airlines, but plans to resume service to Kiev with Air France, its worldwide alliance partner, within 90 days. Delta will display its "DL" designator code on Air France's five weekly roundtrip flights between Paris and Kiev. Accordingly, Delta requires renewal of 2.5 weekly U.S.-Ukraine frequencies.

Renewal of Delta's frequency allocation would be consistent with the public interest as well as the U.S.-Ukraine Memorandum of Consultations dated May 16, 1997, and the U.S.-France Air Transport Agreement signed on June 18, 1998.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Delta respectfully requests that the Department renew Delta's allocation of 2.5 U.S.-Ukraine frequencies for an indefinite period and grant such other and further relief as the Department deems to be consistent with the public interest.
