Dear Ms. Moore:

Pursuant to DOT Order 97-6-33 issued in the 1997/98 Brazil All-Cargo Charter Proceeding on June 30, 1997, Southern Air Transport, Inc. ("Southern Air") was awarded an allocation of one hundred eighty (180) U.S. - Brazil all-cargo charter flights to be operated during the 1997/1998 Brazil Charter Year.

As of June 1, 1998, Southern Air has operated a total of seventy-four (74) U.S. - Brazil all-cargo charter flights during the 1997/98 Brazil All-Cargo Charter Year.<sup>1</sup> See Southern Air U.S. - Brazil Charter Reports, July 1997 - May 1998. Based on Brazil charter flight estimates for the remaining month of the 1997/1998 Brazil All-Cargo Charter Year (June 1998), Southern Air hereby respectfully returns ten (10) charter flights to the U.S. - Brazil All-Cargo Charter Pool.

<sup>1</sup> On May 14, 1998, pursuant to a letter to the Department's Office of International Aviation (U.S. Air Carrier Licensing Division), Southern Air returned a total of eighty-one (81) charter flights to the U.S. - Brazil All-Cargo Charter Pool. Therefore entering the remaining month of the 1997/98 Brazil All-Cargo Charter Year, Southern Air had retained a total of twenty-five (25) U.S. - Brazil all-cargo charter flights.
