
Dear Ms. Bingham:

Pursuant to the blanket Statement of Authorization granted to United Air Lines, Inc. ("United") and Lufthansa German Airlines ("Lufthansa") on April 9, 1998 (Order 98-4-8), United and Lufthansa hereby notify the Department that United's "UA" designator code will be placed on flights operated by Lufthansa between Germany and Italy:

- between Munich (MUC) and
  - Rome (FCO), and Florence (FLR)
- between Dusseldorf (DUS) and
  - Rome (FCO)

The proposed code-share services are consistent with the U.S.-Germany and U.S.-Italy Air Transport Agreements. The services will be implemented on August 9, 2000.
