Pursuant to the blanket Statement of Authorization granted to United Air Lines, Inc. ("United") and Lufthansa German Airlines ("Lufthansa") on April 9, 1998 (Order 98-4-8), United and Lufthansa hereby notify the Department that United's "UA" designator code will be placed on flights operated by Lufthansa:

- between Washington (IAD) and Berlin (TXL)
- between Los Angeles (LAX) and Munich (MUC)

The proposed code-share services are consistent with the U.S.-Germany Open Skies Air Transport Agreement. The services will be implemented on March 25, 2001.
