

ANSWER OF DHL AIRWAYS, INC.

DHL Airways, Inc. ("DHL") has no objection to the application of United Parcel Service Co. ("UPS") for an amendment to its certificate authority to provide all-cargo service on its Route 569 between San Antonio and Mexico City and between Houston and Guadalajara, provided that, as UPS requests, the U.S. Government first obtains the agreement of the Mexican Government to the designation of a second U.S. all-cargo carrier in the Houston-Guadalajara city-pair market. As UPS correctly notes, DHL is currently providing scheduled all-cargo service in this market, Order 96-11-24, and intends to continue to do so.
