OWRT code for GIT Fares from Addis Ababa (ADD), Asmara (ASM), Bujumbura (BJM), Dar Es Salam (DAR), Dire Dawa (DIR), Djibouti (JIB), Entebbe (EBB), Kigali (KGL), Kilimanjaro (JRO), Mogadishu (MGQ), Mombasa (MBA), Nairobi (NBO) to Windhoek (WDH) is amended to read RT.

#### **Resolution 087t**
