

TECHNICAL CORRECTION

Members are referred to Memorandum PTC23 AFR-TC3 Fares 0001 dated 3 December 1996 which circulated the TC23/TC123 Africa - TC3 Specified Fares Tables intended for effect 1 April 1997 and are requested to note the following technical corrections.

Resolution 086v - GIT Fares between Africa and South Asian Subcontinent

Fare from Mumbai (BOM) to Delhi (DEL) which was erroneously created has been deleted.

Resolutions 055n and 065n - First and Economy Class Fares (EH)

Fares from Benghazi (BEN), Tripoli (TIP) to Almaty (ALA) were erroneously created and have been deleted since fares from Libya (LY) are not specified.

Members are also requested to file these corrections with their Government Authorities wherever necessary. Filing formalities with the Canadian and US Governments, as applicable, will be accomplished by IATA.
