allocating such frequencies contemplates that if not used by the carrier to which they are assigned, such frequencies are to be returned to DOT for reallocation to another operator. Under these circumstances, and in light of the Department's expressed intentions with respect to the use of the limited Argentina scheduled all-cargo frequencies, Polar Air submits that the requested renewal of FWIA's weekly U.S.-Argentina all-cargo frequency be denied, and that the frequency authorization revert to DOT for appropriate reallocation.

WHEREFORE, Polar Air Cargo, Inc. requests that the application of FWIA for renewal of its scheduled all-cargo frequency allocation for U.S.-Argentina service be denied.
