& REFUND OF FILING FEE


Pursuant to statements submitted by Member airlines of the International Air Transport Association (IATA), the undersigned has been constituted to be their attorney-in-fact for filing with the Department of Transportation copies of agreements adopted by the IATA Traffic Conferences.

On their behalf, and pursuant to Sections 41308 and 41309 of Title 49 of the United States Code and Parts 303.03, 303.05 and 303.30(c) of Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations, I filed with the Department on July 16, 1997, an application for approval of a passenger services agreement (PSC/MV/107 dated June 20, 1997) involving Recommended Practice 1784 and Resolution 898a.

Resolution 898a, however, should not have been submitted for approval. The resolution deals with the passenger agency conference, not the passenger services conference. Furthermore, the resolution previously had been filed with the Department in Docket OST-97-2607 and granted stamped approval and antitrust immunity on June 12, 1997. In Docket OST-97-2727, Resolution 898a should have been submitted for background information only.

This petition is to request the **withdrawal of Resolution 898a in Docket OST-97-2727** and a **refund** of the \$61 filing fee.
