

**DELTA SEEKS RENEWAL OF ITS EXEMPTION AUTHORITY FOR
SERVICE BETWEEN THE FOLLOWING CITY-PAIRS**

(1) Transborder Routes:¹

Los Angeles - Leon;
Houston - Mexico City; and
Miami - Merida.

(2) Between Atlanta, Dallas/Ft. Worth, Newark/New York, Los Angeles, Orlando, and Las Vegas, on the one hand, and each of the following points in Mexico, on the other hand (on a code-share basis via Mexico City, in conjunction with Aeromexico):

Acapulco;
Cancun;
Guadalajara;²
Monterrey; and
Puerto Vallarta.

(3) Between Los Angeles, on the one hand, and each of the following points in Mexico, on the other hand (on a code-share basis via Puerto Vallarta, in conjunction with Aeromexico):

Aguascalientes; and
Leon.

¹ Order 97-6-26 also granted exemption authority to Delta for the Dallas/Ft. Worth-Ixtapa/Zihuatanejo route. By letter dated September 4, 1997, Delta notified the Department that it had discontinued service on this route. Thus, Delta is not herein seeking renewal of its Dallas/Ft. Worth-Ixtapa/Zihuatanejo exemption because the authority is dormant.
