

**ECONOMIC AUTHORITY FOR TRANSFER FROM SOUTHERN AIR
TRANSPORT, INC. TO SOUTHERN AIR INC.**

I. Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity

1. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Charter Air Transportation granted by Order 80-1-87 authorizing:
 - a. The carriage of persons, property and mail between the United States or the District of Columbia or any territory or possession of the United States, and
 1. Any point in Canada
 2. Any point in Mexico
 3. Any point in Jamaica, the Bahama Islands, Bermuda, Haiti, the Dominican Republic, Trinidad, Aruba, the Leeward and Windward Islands and any other foreign place in the Gulf of Mexico and the Caribbean Sea;
 4. Any point in Central or South America; and
 5. Any point in Australasia, Indonesia or Asia as far west as longitude 70 degrees east via a transpacific routing.
 - b. Persons and their accompanied baggage and mail between any point in any state of the United States or the District of Columbia or any territory or possession of the United States, and any point in Greenland, Iceland, the Azores, Europe, Africa and Asia as far east as, and including, India.
 - c. Persons and property pursuant to contracts with the Department of Defense.
2. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Charter Air Transportation granted by Order 80-9-106 authorizing:
 - a. The carriage of property and mail between any point in any state of the United States or the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands, on the one hand, and points in Greenland, Iceland, the Azores, Europe, Africa, and Asia as far east as (and including) India, on the other hand.

3. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Engage in Foreign Air Transportation of Property and Mail granted by Order 95-1-6 authorizing service between any point in the United States, and
 - a. Hong Kong
 - b. Australia
 - c. South Korea
 - d. Taiwan
 - e. Ireland
4. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Engage in Interstate All-Cargo Air Transportation under 49 U.S.C. § 41103 as granted by Order 78-5-120.
5. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Engage in Interstate and Foreign Charter Air Transportation of Property and Mail under 49 U.S.C. § 41102 as granted by Orders 79-12-31, 80-1-87 and 80-9-106.

II. Exemption Authority

1. Exemption granted by Order 95-3-31 (renewal pending in Docket OST-95-172) to engage in foreign air transportation of property and mail between points in the United States and Arica, Antofagasta and Santiago, Chile, via the intermediate and beyond points Bogota and Cali, Colombia; Caracas, Venezuela; Rio de Janeiro and Sao Paulo, Brazil; Buenos Aires and Cordoba, Argentina; Montevideo, Uruguay; Asuncion, Paraguay; La Paz, Bolivia; Lima, Peru; Quito and Quayaquil, Ecuador; Panama City, Panama; and Mexico City, Guadalajara, and Monterrey Mexico.
2. Exemption most recently renewed by Order 97-6-16 (renewal pending in Docket OST-99-1153) to provide scheduled foreign air transportation of property and mail between a point or points in the United States, on the one hand, and the coterminal points Barranquilla, Bogota, Cali and Cartagena, Colombia, on the other, via intermediate points.
3. Exemption most recently renewed by Order 97-8-17 to provide scheduled foreign air transportation of property and mail between New York, New York, and Prestwick/Glasgow Scotland.
4. Exemption granted by Notice of Action Taken June 18, 1998 to provide scheduled foreign air transportation of property and mail between a point or points in the United States, via intermediate points, to a point or points in the Republic of Panama, and beyond, and to integrate this authority with its existing certificate and exemption authority.
