CERTIFICATION OF ATLANTIC COAST JET, INC.

Atlantic Coast Jet, Inc. ("ACJet") hereby certifies, in accordance with the provisions of 49 U.S.C. § 41716(a) and Order 2000-4-11 (issued April 14, 2000), that it intends to utilize twenty-two (22) daily slot exemptions at New York LaGuardia Airport ("LaGuardia") to operate four daily roundtrip flights between LaGuardia and Portland, Maine, three daily roundtrip flights between LaGuardia and Greenville/Spartanburg, South Carolina and four daily roundtrip flights between LaGuardia and Rochester, New York. These flights will be conducted by ACJet as Delta Connection carrier flights.

On March 24, 2000, Delta Connection Carriers Comair, Inc., Atlantic Southeast Airlines, Inc. and ACJet applied for exemptions from Subparts K and S of 14 C.F.R. Part 93,

pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 41716, for regional jet services to and from LaGuardia. Pursuant to Order 2000-4-11 (issued April 14, 2000), the Department granted blanket approval for such slot exemptions, and directed all carriers seeking additional slots at LaGuardia under § 41716 to certify that their proposed operations met all of the requirements of that section. Applicants were also directed to verify the certification as required by 14 C.F.R. § 302.4(b).

Accordingly, attached hereto as Exhibit A is the Certification of Atlantic Coast Jet, as executed by Michael S. Davis, Atlantic Coast Jet's Chief Operating Officer, certifying that Atlantic Coast Jet meets all applicable statutory requirements and containing the verification required by 14 C.F.R. § 302.4(b).
