CERTIFICATION OF ATLANTIC COAST JET

I, Michael S. Davis, Chief Operating Officer of Atlantic Coast Jet, Inc. ("ACJet"), hereby certify that the services to be provided by ACJet as a Delta Connection carrier at New York LaGuardia Airport ("LaGuardia") as described in this Certification meet all of the statutory requirements set forth in 49 U.S.C. § 41716(a), as amended by the Wendell H. Ford Aviation Investment and Reform Act for the 21st Century ("AIR-21"), and further specifically certify as follows:

1. ACJet proposes to use Fairchild regional jet aircraft in its LaGuardia-Burlington, Vermont (BTV) operations. ACJet's entire fleet of regional jet aircraft is Stage 3 compliant.

2. All aircraft that ACJet proposes to use and will use in its LaGuardia-Burlington service will have fewer than 71 seats.

3. The airport serving Burlington from which ACJet's proposed service will operate is a small hub airport as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 41714(h)(8).

4. ACJet will utilize a total of eight slot exemptions at LaGuardia, representing new service by it as a Delta Connection carrier.

5. ACJet did not offer nonstop LaGuardia-Burlington service as of the week of November 1, 1999.

6. The communities and airports to be served with these eight slots are New York, New York (LGA) and Burlington, Vermont (BTV). The planned effective date of the LaGuardia-Burlington service is October 1, 2000. The times of the slots requested are as follows:


