- 072y Paragraph 4) is amended as follows as there are no fares between Germany and Hungary

4) FLIGHT APPLICATION

A) Exceptions

- 1) to/from Horta, Ponta Delgada, Terceira: not applicable for routings which include travel within Azores
- 2) ~~between Berlin and Budapest~~
 - a) ~~higher level: travel permitted via Frankfurt, Munich~~
 - b) ~~lower level: travel not permitted via Frankfurt, Munich~~
- 3) 2) between Dresden, Leipzig and Bosnia and Herzegovina, Slovenia, Yugoslavia, Zagreb: travel permitted via Frankfurt, Munich

- 072y Paragraph 17)A)1) is deleted as there are no fares between Germany and Hungary; subsequent Paragraphs are renumbered

17) HIGHER INTERMEDIATE POINT AND MILEAGE EXCEPTIONS

A) 1) ~~between Berlin, Hamburg and Budapest: travel permitted via Dusseldorf, Frankfurt, Munich without mileage surcharge and any excess mileage may be ignored~~
