Pursuant to a request from Bill Bertram, enclosed is a revised summary of the Heathrow and Gatwick slot holdings data that was included with Exhibit JA-20 of the Joint Application of American Airlines and British Airways for Antitrust Immunity, filed on August 10, 2001. <u>Heading</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Carrier	The code for the airline holding the slot (e.g., BA = British Airways)
Hold	The slot time held by the carrier (in Universal Time Control)
Start	The date on which the slot is first held
End	The date on which the slot is last held
A/D	Arrival/Departure
DOOP	Days of Operation (e.g., 1 = Monday, 7 = Sunday)
A/C	Air Craft Type
