**REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL
& REFUND OF FILING FEE**

Pursuant to statements submitted by Member airlines of the International Air Transport Association (IATA), the undersigned has been constituted to be their attorney-in-fact for filing with the Department of Transportation copies of agreements adopted by the IATA Traffic Conferences.

On their behalf, and pursuant to Sections 41308 and 41309 of Title 49 of the United States Code and Parts 303.03, 303.05 and 303.30(c) of Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations, I filed with the Department on June 29, 2002, an application for approval of Composite Cargo Resolutions in IATA Memoranda CTC COMP 0394, CTC COMP 0401 and CTC COMP 0397.

Due to inadvertent omissions in these documents, IATA wishes to withdraw the application in its entirety. IATA will prepare new memoranda and submit them shortly in a new application.

Therefore, this petition is to request the withdrawal of the application in Docket OST-2002-12700 and a refund of \$2,257 in filing fees.
