SUPPLEMENT TO  
APPLICATION OF EVERGREEN INTERNATIONAL AIRLINES, INC.  
FOR RENEWAL OF EXEMPTION AUTHORITY

On September 9, 2002, Evergreen International Airlines, Inc. ("Evergreen") filed an application to renew its exemption authority last renewed by Notice of Action Taken, dated November 8, 2000, to engage in scheduled foreign air transportation of property and mail between Anchorage, Alaska, on the one hand, and Khabarovsk, Petropavlovsk, Vladivostok, and Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk, Russia, on the other, and beyond to Hong Kong, without local traffic rights between Russia and Hong Kong. The Notice of Action Taken also authorized Evergreen to integrate this authority with its other exemption and certificate authorities. Through an oversight Evergreen neglected to seek renewal of the integration authority. Consequently, Evergreen is filing this Supplement to clarify that it also requests renewal of its authority to integrate the Russia exemption authority with

other exemption and certificate authorities held by Evergreen to the extent permitted by international agreements.

WHEREFORE, Evergreen International Airlines, Inc., respectfully requests that the Department of Transportation renew the exemption and integration authority as requested herein.
