





**DEPARTMENT ACTION ON WAIVER REQUEST IN DOCKET OST-2003-14367**  
(Notice of Delta Air Lines, Inc., Comair, Inc., Atlantic Southeast Airlines, Inc., and  
Korean Air Lines Co., Ltd of Additional Code-Share Services and Request for Waiver of  
30-Day Requirement, filed April 25, 2003)

By Statements of Authorization issued August 6, 1998 (98-394) and March 11, 2003,  
(OST-2003-14367) Delta, Comair and Atlantic Southeast were granted blanket authority  
to code share with Korean Airlines, subject to the condition that they notify the  
Department no later than 30 days before they begin any new code-share service under the  
code-share services authorized. The carriers have requested a waiver of this requirement  
to enable them to begin service immediately upon confirmation by the Department.<sup>1</sup>  
There were no answers to the requested waiver. Under these circumstances, we find it in  
the public interest to grant the requested waiver.
