



**NOTICE OF AIR MIDWEST, INC. TO TERMINATE SCHEDULED AIR SERVICE AT GREENBRIER/WHITE SULPHUR SPRINGS, WEST VIRGINIA**

Air Midwest, Inc. ("Air Midwest") respectfully serves notice upon the Department of Transportation, in accordance with 14 C.F.R. §323.3 and 14 C.F.R. §323.4, of its intent to discontinue scheduled non-subsidized Essential Air Service between Greenbrier/White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia and Charlotte, North Carolina.

Order 85-8-77 set forth the essential air service determination at Greenbrier/White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia to require two one-stop roundtrips each weekday and each weekend to Charlotte and two one-stop roundtrips each weekday and each weekend to Washington D.C. Air Midwest is currently providing the following scheduled service to Greenbrier/White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia using Beech 1900D aircraft:

CLT LWB 2:05pm - 3:05pm : Sun - Sat

LWB CLT 3:25pm - 4:25pm : Sun - Sat


The termination of service by Air Midwest will reduce air transportation at Greenbrier/White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia to a level below the essential air service determination set forth in Order 85-8-77.

Though Air Midwest would prefer to continue providing scheduled air service in Greenbrier/White Sulphur Springs, the substantial costs resulting from increased federal regulations for regional carriers makes it impossible to continue without Essential Air Service subsidy. The absence of this subsidy requires Air Midwest to advise the Department that scheduled air service will be discontinued.

Air Midwest is hereby providing public notice of its intent to terminate scheduled air service with the expiration of the 90-day notice period as required. Any objections to this Notice to Terminate Service must be filed within twenty (20) days from the date of this filing, in accordance with 14 C.F.R. §323.10.

Air Midwest will make all required notifications as outlined in 14 C.F.R. §323.7.
