

On January 27, 2004, pursuant to the blanket statement of authorization granted to Delta and Air France in the captioned docket, Delta and Air France informed the Department that due to the planned closure of the Bologna (BLQ) airport, Delta planned to begin offering codeshare service on Air France flights to Rimini (RMI) in lieu of BLQ on or about May 2, 2004. The carriers wish to clarify that they intend to resume service to BLQ upon completion of the scheduled construction activities at that airport.
