**SUPPLEMENT NO. 6
TO APPLICATION OF
BOSTON-MAINE AIRWAYS CORP.**

Boston-Maine Airways Corp., d/b/a Pan Am Clipper Connection ("BMAC") hereby submits this Supplement No. 6 to its April 18, 2003 application for issuance of a new or amended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing BMAC to engage in foreign scheduled air transportation operations utilizing large aircraft.

The purpose of this Supplement No. 6 is to furnish certain updated fitness information in anticipation of imminent final action by the Department on BMAC's pending applications for authority to operate large aircraft in this proceeding and a concurrent related proceeding in Docket OST-00-7668.



Concurrently herewith, BMAC is filing a Supplement No. 12 to its application for interstate large aircraft authority in Docket OST-00-7668. That filing contains BMAC's submission of certain additional updated fitness information and exhibits relevant to the fitness-determination issue involved in BMAC's application for authority to operate large aircraft. The foregoing information and exhibits, and the fitness review at issue, are identically applicable to both of BMAC's interstate and foreign large aircraft applications.

In that circumstance, BMAC hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the entirety of its Supplement No. 12 filing in Docket OST-00-7668 as its Supplement No. 6 to its application for foreign authority in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, BMAC requests the Department to issue a new or amended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing BMAC to provide foreign air transportation of persons, property and mail, utilizing both small and large aircraft, as requested in this application.


