Dear Assistant Secretary Bhatia:

By its Notice served August 26, 2005 the DOT asked carriers holding international route authority to notify the Department if they wished to be awarded blanket route integration authority consistent with the terms of the Notice. On behalf of Evergreen International Airlines, Inc. the undersigned hereby advises the Department that Evergreen seeks to obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity for route integration authority.

Like others that have commented in this Docket, Evergreen urges that such authority be issued prospectively (thereby avoiding the constant need to seek a certificate amendment) and to make the term of the certificate indefinite, and not just for a five year term.
