FOR RENEWAL OF EXEMPTION AUTHORITY**


American Eagle Airlines, Inc., under 49 USC 40109 and 14 CFR Part 377, hereby applies for renewal of its exemption, initially granted by Notice of Action Taken in this docket on April 30, 2004, authorizing scheduled foreign air transportation of persons, property, and mail between Dallas/Ft. Worth, Texas and Torreon, Mexico.

In filing this application, American Eagle invokes the automatic extension provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, 5 USC 558(c), as implemented by 14 CFR Part 377. American Eagle's Dallas/Ft. Worth-Torreon exemption would expire on April 30, 2006 absent this renewal application. This application is timely under Section 377.10(c) since it is filed more than 60 days in advance of the expiration date.

American Eagle operates daily nonstop service between Dallas/Ft. Worth and Torreon using 46-seat ERJ-145 aircraft. Renewal is fully consistent with the U.S.-Mexico Air Transport Agreement, as amended, and with the public interest.

In response to the Department's Notice of August 23, 2005 on streamlining regulatory procedures (OST-2005-22228), American Eagle has requested corresponding certificate authority for the Dallas/Ft. Worth-Torreon route. See Application of American Eagle Airlines and Executive Airlines d/b/a American Eagle for certificate of public convenience and necessity, August 26, 2005 (OST-2005-22261). We urge expedited approval of that application to avoid the need for successive renewals in exemption dockets.
