

Dear Ms. Beard:

By Notice of Action Taken dated April 5, 2006, in the above-referenced docket, the Department granted exemption authority to Aerovias de Mexico, S.A. de C.V. ("Aeromexico") to engage in foreign air transportation between Monterrey, Mexico, and Corpus Christi, Texas. It also deferred action on exemption authority between Reynosa, Mexico, and Corpus Christi, Texas, since the Reynosa airport had not been assessed by TSA. The exemption is to expire on April 5, 2007. Please be advised that Aeromexico does not intend to seek renewal of the Monterrey-Corpus Christi exemption nor does it intend to pursue exemption authority between Reynosa and Corpus Christi.
