APPLICATION OF HAWAIIAN AIRLINES, INC.
FOR CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY IN RESPONSE TO NOTICE ON
BLANKET OPEN-SKIES CERTIFICATE AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the Notice served April 3, 2007 in the captioned docket (hereinafter the “Notice”) , Hawaiian Airlines, Inc (hereinafter “ Hawaiian”) applies for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate between the United States and all countries with which the United States has “Open Skies” agreements now or in the future¹. Further Hawaiian asks that such authority allow it to integrate that authority so it may operate to and from any country to which DOT has given it certificate or exemption authority and to which Hawaiian has been designated. Lastly DOT asks that Hawaiian be designed to each of those countries so it may begin service as the market place may dictate.

In support thereof Hawaiian states as follows:

1. Hawaiian has its principal office located at 3375 Koapaka Street, Suite G-350, Honolulu, HI 96819.
2. Hawaiian is incorporated under the laws of the State of Hawaii.

¹ This request includes authority to fly to MALIAT countries as discussed herein.

3. Hawaiian is a citizen of the United States within the meaning of 49 U.S.C. § 40102(a) (15). The President and two-thirds of the officers and directors of the company are U.S. citizens. Additionally, to Hawaiian's knowledge, U.S. citizens hold at least 75% of Hawaiian's voting stock.

4. Hawaiian has repeatedly been found fit, willing and able to provide interstate and foreign air transportation. The Department may take official notice of Hawaiian's continuing fitness and its foreign air carrier permits, including Order 97-3-24 and Order 99-4-4 authorizing service to Canada and Japan as well as a number of orders authorizing service to Singapore, Korea, Thailand, Rarotonga, Nadi, Fiji, Papeete, Indonesia, Auckland, New Zealand, Sidney, Australia, Tonga, Taupai, Tonga and Apia, Western Samoa.


5. The authority requested is consistent with the terms of the Notice and Order 2007-4-2 in which authority was granted to those countries with existing Open Skies Agreements and to all countries that prospectively enter into Open Skies Agreements. As to countries with whom an Open Skies Agreement is negotiated but not in force, Hawaiian asks that such authority be granted when the agreement goes into effect.

7. Hawaiian submits that its application raises no environmental or energy issues. Approval of the application will not result in near term increase in fuel consumption of 10 million gallons or more.

8. Hawaiian asks that the Order issued hereunder also incorporate those countries that are signatories to the Multilateral Agreement on the Liberalization of International Air Transportation ("MALIAT").

For the forgoing reason, Hawaiian request the Department issue it certificate authority for service to all Open Skies and MALIAT countries consistent with its Notice and this request and provide for integration of such authority with all other authority held by Hawaiian consistent with the Final Order in Docket OST-2005-22228.


