On August 3, 2006, the Department of Transportation ("Department") renewed America West Airlines, Inc.'s ("America West") existing exemption authority to provide scheduled foreign air transportation between Oakland, California, and San Jose del Cabo, Mexico for a period of two years. (See Notice of Action Taken, August 3, 2006, Docket OST-2004-18440 ("Notice").)

In accordance with the Conditions set forth in the Notice, America West hereby advises the Department that it will no longer operate Oakland-San Jose del Cabo service effective immediately. Accordingly, America West respectfully provides notice of dormancy with respect to this route.


