Air New Zealand has advised that it proposes to perform a seventh freedom passenger charter from Sydney to Kona, in Hawaii. The charter, on behalf of Amway and using B747-400 aircraft, would operate on 7 October 2007. After the passengers had disembarked at Kona, the aircraft would position to Honolulu. It would then return to Kona on 12 October to uplift the passengers for carriage to Sydney.

This letter is to advise that New Zealand will approve similar requests submitted by United States carriers to operate seventh freedom passenger charters from New Zealand to third countries.
