Delta Air Lines, Inc. ("Delta") has concluded its polling of the representatives of all U.S. carriers currently offering U.S. - Argentina service, concerning the above-referenced application dated June 9, 2008. No carrier representative has objected to the application.

American Airlines, which filed its own request for additional U.S.-Argentina frequencies the day after Delta's application was filed, has advised that it does not object so long as its own application is granted contemporaneously. Delta does not object to the granting of American's request, so long as Delta's application is granted contemporaneously.

Delta therefore requests that the authority Delta seeks be granted as soon as possible.
