

Dear Mr. DeVany:

As suggested in your letter dated May 29, 1998, Keene's eligibility for continued subsidized air service is in jeopardy because the subsidy per passenger exceeds that which is allowed under the EAS Program. The Keene City Council therefore has voted to request the Department of Transportation (DOT) to allow Colgan Air to terminate its subsidized service effective September 1, 1998.

It is our understanding that by doing so, the City preserves its right to petition the DOT to reenter the EAS Program at some point in the future. Please advise at your earliest convenience as to the status of this request.
