EXCHANGE OF NOTES

The Department of State presents its compliments to the Embassy of Australia and with reference to recent discussions concerning civil aviation has the honor to propose that Sections I and II on routes of the existing Annex to the Air Transport Agreement between the Government of the United States and the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, done at Washington on December 3, 1946, as amended (the "Air Transport Agreement"), be replaced by Sections I to III attached to this note (the "Agreement on Routes") and that existing Sections III to VI be renumbered IV to VII.

The Department of State has the further honor to propose that the Agreements on Capacity set out in the attached Memoranda of Understanding which are acceptable to the Government of the United States of America also be accepted by the Government of Australia.

The Department of State has the further honor to propose the following additional amendments to the Air Transport Agreement:

- Articles [] and existing Section VII of the Annex to the Air Transport Agreement are deleted;
- Articles [] attached to this Note are added to the Air Transport Agreement;
- The Exchange of Notes at Washington on December 22, 1987, constituting an Agreement on Aviation Security amending the Air Transport Agreement, is superseded by the deletion of former Section VII of the Annex and the addition of new Article [] to the Agreement.

The amendments to the Air Transport Agreement reached through this Exchange of Notes shall remain in force in accordance with that Agreement. The Agreements on Capacity shall remain in force for three years from August 20, 1988. Thereafter the arrangements in each Memorandum of Understanding of the Agreements on Capacity shall remain in force in accordance with its terms.

If the above proposal is acceptable to the Government of Australia, the Department of State proposes that this Note and the Embassy of Australia's Note in reply shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of the Embassy of Australia's Note in reply. The Agreement on Routes and the Agreements on Capacity will shall have force from August 20, 1988. All other parts of this Agreement shall have force from the date of the Embassy of Australia's Note in reply.

The Department of State avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of Australia the assurances of its highest consideration.
