"I have the honour to present my compliments and to refer to the March 16, 1989 Air Services Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Austrian Federal Government, with Annexes, (the Agreement) and to the recent discussions held by representatives of our two governments in Washington, March 7 - 8, 1995, to consider revisions to the Agreement.


In the light of the understandings reached in those discussions, I have the honour to propose on behalf of the Government of the United States of America that the Agreement be amended according to the Attachment to this note.
